DESCRIPTION

The Land at Bardarroch extends in total to approximately 30.39 Ac (12.30 ha) and is contained within two field parcels. All the land is graded by the James Hutton Institute as Grade 4(1) and is used for grazing purposes with a crop of hay being taken in the summer months. All the land is serviced by a mains water supply. Most of the boundary fencing is in a stock proof condition. The land is of good quality, capable of producing numerous silage crops throughout the summer months. The land can be accessed from a shared road with shared maintenance leading to the field entrance with a right of access marked on the plan as A - B.

CLAWBACK

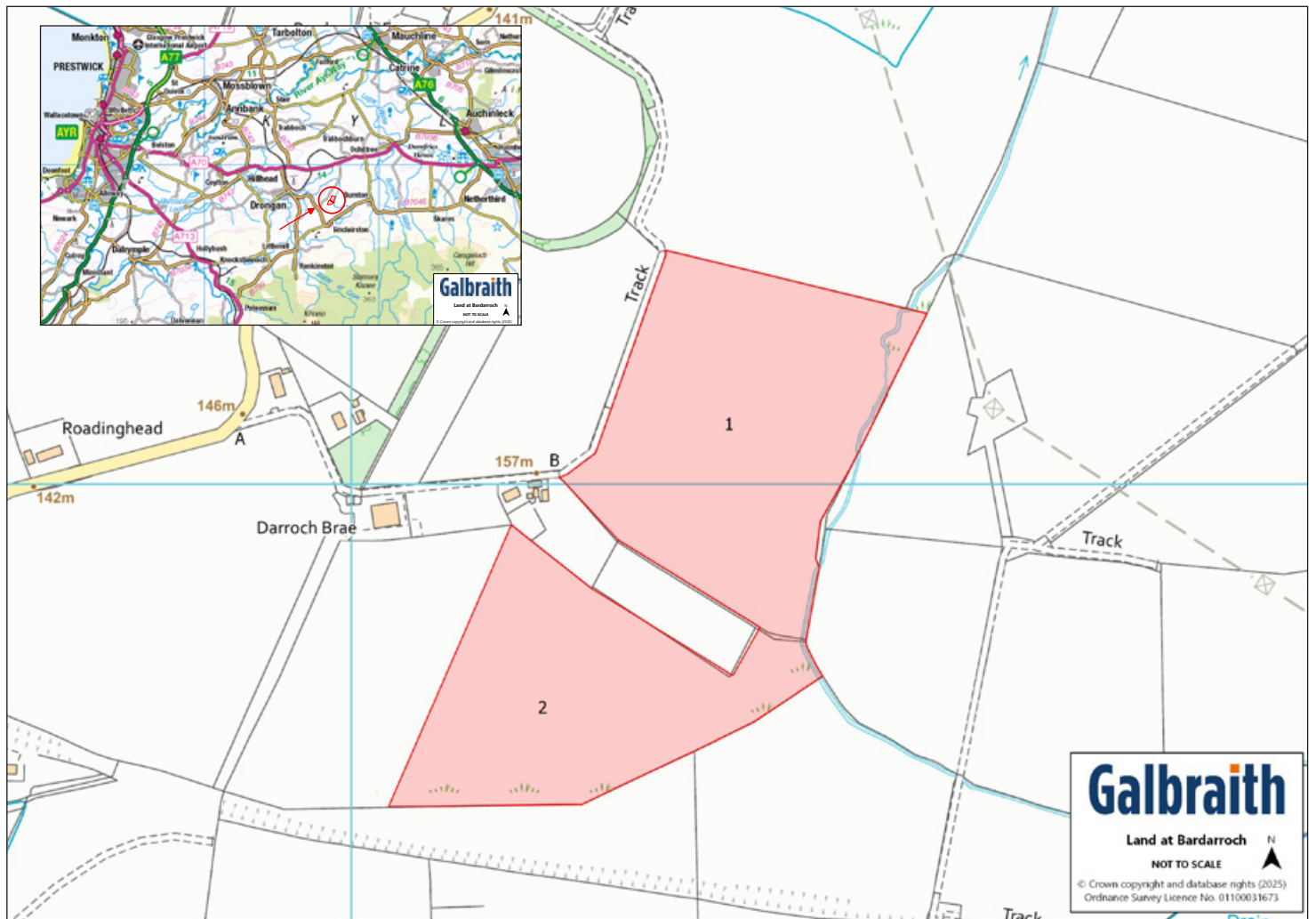
