

HEALTH AND SAFETY STATEMENT

 persons that may arise from the Firm's activities;
- Providing adequate working conditions, with proper facilities to safeguard the Health & Safety of all employees and to ensure that any work which is undertaken produces no unnecessary risk to health or safety;
- Encouraging persons on the premises to co-operate with the Firm in all safety matters, in the identification of hazards which may exist and in the reporting of any condition which may appear dangerous or unsatisfactory;
- Ensure the provision and maintenance of plant, equipment and systems of work that are safe and maintain safe arrangements for the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances:
- Providing sufficient information, instruction, training and supervision to enable everyone to avoid hazards and contribute to their own safety and health;
- Providing specific information, instruction, training and supervision to personnel who have particular Health & Safety responsibilities; and
- Assessing risks in respect of new or expectant mothers and young people under the age of eighteen employed by the Firm.

Galbraith is committed to working with all stakeholders to support effective operation of the company's Health and Safety System and the achieving the business's objectives and targets.

This Health and Safety Statement will be made available to stakeholders and will be placed on the business's web site. The Policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it is appropriate for the business's operations.
